GM Corner:

With Spring approaching we have started prepping for the summer season. Some areas will be sprayed in the upcoming weeks for weeds so please be mindful of those areas with children and pets. The chemicals we use are pet and child friendly, but I would still avoid areas where spraying has been conducted to be extra cautious.

The playground equipment that was condemned in last fall's safety inspection has been inspected and those items that need to be repaired or removed have been identified. The process of completing repairs/removal will take place during April and we will be opening those areas as they meet the safety criteria. We have a limited amount of replacement equipment on-hand and there are no funds for purchase of new equipment this year.

A reminder that signage on agency property is limited to non-commercial signs only. All signage must be approved by the agency in advance and stickers are placed on the signs when approval is granted (so they are not removed). Signs are only allowed in designated areas (another reason for getting your sign approved so you know where to put them).

Greens:

Winter 2024 Golf Course Update

This winter has provided a mix of conditions that have benefited all things concerned with the golf course. Roughly a month of snow cover gave the course some protection and a break from golf during the coldest part of the year. We opened for play at the end of January and have had many productive playing days. The course received needed rain to keep the turf crowns hydrated but allowed the course to remain open.

The staff is currently servicing mowers, getting them ready for the upcoming season. We have also tried to smooth out some of the asphalt cart paths with road base. This spring we hope to finish the irrigation wiring on holes 10 and 18. Another area of concentration will be reseeding fairway bare spots. We will also continue to work on the irrigation system around the course as needed. We are planning to aerify the greens mid-April, weather permitting. We have a contractor scheduled to spray for broadleaf weeds on the golf course and green belts when it warms up, possibly end of March/early April. Our overall goal is to continue to improve the golf course within the confines of our budget, eventually becoming self-sustaining and relieving the financial burden of the agency.
